CAMP SITE RULES

1. ARRIVAL – All groups must book in at the camp reception before unloading or pitching tents
2. CAMP FEES – Full camp fees must be paid at the camp reception before groups leave the site.
3. DEPARTURE – All groups must have sites and/or accommodation inspected before leaving.
4. VEHICLES – Vehicles are not allowed on camping areas. Please ensure that leaders and parents are informed that only vehicles carrying equipment may be unloaded and loaded on the site roads, personal gear can be carried to and from the designated car parks. A 10 mph maximum speed limit is in force at all times
5. ACCIDENTS – Accidents and illness must be reported to the Reception without delay.
6. FIRE PLACES – No ground fires except in designated areas. Altar fires are available for loan.
7. WET PITS – No pits to be dug. Please use drainage bags.
8. TREES – No felling or cutting of trees without authority from the Site Manager.
9. DOGS and HORSES – Are **not** permitted on the site
10. SECURITY – Managers and Service Teams carry out security checks. Site users are asked to be vigilant at all times and report to the Managers or Service Team as necessary.
11. LITTER – All site users are asked to KEEP BEAUDESERT TIDY. Please ensure that waste is placed in bags before putting in the waste bins. Smokers are requested to dispose of cigarette ends in bins not on the grass or floor.
12. NO SMOKING POLICY – In the interests of safety and hygiene the Beaudesert Trust maintains a no smoking policy in all buildings and activity areas on the site.
