### Qualification or Course Details

Level 3 Award in Emergency First Aid at Work

### Venue & Date(s)

The course will be base at Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre. Please report to Reception at least 15 9am for a 9.30 start to 5pm.

### Content

Full manuals & training materials will be provided throughout for candidates to take home at the end of the sessions. Candidates may wish to bring a pen and paper for making notes. The course may involve an aspect of role play and scenarios participation, so we suggest that the candidates dress appropriately (loose comfortable clothing suitable for bending, kneeling, etc)

Depending on the sessions required there may be short reading tasks for attendees to complete in their own time.

### Learner requirements

Be 16 years of age or older. All candidates are required to produce a form of ID during the first day of the course. This should ideally be photographic (passport, driving licence, company ID), but we can also accept a signed debit/credit card.

We do ask that you inform us as soon as possible you have any pre-existing injuries / conditions that may affect their ability to do practical work. Candidates should not do anything that may worsen a condition, and we can make reasonable adjustments where possible. However, candidates should be physically capable of conducting the task required for the qualification.

Candidates do not need good literacy skills to complete the course or qualification, but there will be a workbook to complete. Should anyone experience difficulties with this style of assessment this can be completed verbally in certain circumstances. Please contact us for further details.
