Qualification or Course Details

The NSRA Youth Proficiency Award will be base at Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre. Please report to Reception at least 15 minutes before the course starts.

Saturday & Sunday 9am-5pm.

Content

Full manuals & training materials will be provided throughout for candidates to take home at the end of the sessions. Candidates may wish to bring a pen and paper for making notes. The course may involve an aspect of role play and scenarios participation, so we suggest that the candidates dress appropriately for working outside.

Depending on the sessions required there may be short reading tasks for attendees to complete in their own time.

Learner requirements

It is open to anyone aged 21 or over on the last day of the course. All candidates are required to produce a form of ID during the first day of the course.

We do ask that you inform us as soon as possible you have any pre-existing injuries / conditions that may affect their ability to do practical work. Candidates should not do anything that may worsen a condition, and we can make reasonable adjustments where possible. However, candidates should be physically capable of conducting the task required for the qualification.

Candidates do not need good literacy skills to complete the course or qualification, but there will be a workbook to complete. Should anyone experience difficulties with this style of assessment this can be completed verbally in certain circumstances. Please contact us for further details.
