## **DRONE POLICY**

We do not allow drones to be on site, nor flown from the site, nor flown over the site without the following permission.

If permitted by the Centre Manager, we allow Trustees, staff, contractors, or customers to use a drone on site for specific events only, and only by abiding with these conditions:

- a. Drones must be piloted by a CAA licensed pilot;
- b. The drone must be CAA registered and have its registration number clearly shown on it;
- c. Pilots must demonstrate that they carry sufficient third-party insurance covering any possible accident or incident;
- d. Drones should be flown strictly in accordance with the Drones and Model Aircraft Code of October 2019 (see below);
- e. Drones must stay within the boundary of the Beaudesert Trust and not stray above or cause a nuisance to neighbouring properties.
