### What is Beaudesert Park?

Beaudesert Park was owned by the Marquis of Anglesey. In 1937, The Marquis gifted the parkland to the Scouts, Guides and youth of Staffordshire and West Mercia. The lands were conveyed to a Charitable Trust—'The King George V Memorial Scouts and Guides Recreational Lands', more commonly known as 'The Beaudesert Trust'. Beaudesert Park continues to be run as a charity for the benefit of Scouts, Guides and youth organisations including schools and the Princes Trust.



## Who are Friends of Beau?

The Friends of Beau are a network of supporters interested in the past, present and future of Beaudesert Outdoor Activity Centre. Friends are the Trust's fan club and its biggest supporters. We are admirers of its history, and we work together supporting its future both financially and with practical help.

### **Events**

## Finances and fundraising

We have been investing in our site for many years now, repairing roadways and building new activities and buildings – but there is still much to do. Covid closures hit us hard financially and we have had to put our development plans on hold. We have now relaunched Friends of Beau with a new purpose to gain awareness of what we do, to raise funds and increase our volunteers. Alongside this we have relaunched our development plan and one of our first projects will be to raise money to install a new climbing tower to replace the old one at the back of the Cal Day Centre. This is an exciting project and will provide a fantastic facility for years to come. We also have lots of smaller projects to improve the grounds and the accommodation.

### **FAQs**

Q: Can I walk when I want in Beaudesert Park?

A: Membership does not give you free access to the grounds and you are not able to turn up and walk. Our Safeguarding policy prioritises keeping the young users of the site safe.

Q: How much is membership?

A: £30 per Adult £15 for Junior membership (16s and under)

Q: Why has the membership gone up?

A: Inflation, the price has varied between free and £10 for a long time. All visitors to the park should contribute to the upkeep.

Q: Is Beaudesert Park still a charity?

A: Yes, very much so. We receive no external funding and rely on our visitor fees, grants and donations. We are a charity for young people and we do our best to offer adventure experiences to all backgrounds.

Q: I have a lifetime membership what do I do?

A: Existing life membership will be honoured, but you may like to make a donation in respect of the new launch.

Q: As a member can I get the 20% discount for my family or friends?

A: No, the discount only applies to members

Q: As a member can I get the 20% discount on camping and activities for my group?

A: No, the discount is only on specific events and only for Friends of Beau members.
